PAYMENT FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES
PROVIDED BY HOGG ENGINEERING CORPORATION
O'Hara Place Storm Replacement

Project under \$12M General Obligation Bond

WHEREAS, under the laws of the State of Alabama, the City Council of the City of Selma, controls and manages the finances of the City; *and*

WHEREAS, per a Special Municipal Election held on the 27th day October , 2009 the citizens of Selma approved a \$12,000,000 in General Obligation Bond for purposes, including but not limited to, constructing improvements to the sanitary sewer facilities, streets and roads within the City of Selma and incidental costs related to such projects including professional engineering fees; *and*

WHEREAS, the O'Hara Place Storm Replacement project is one of the projects encumbered under said bond; *and*

WHEREAS, Hogg Engineering Corporation rendered professional engineering and inspection services to the City of Selma relevant to the O'Hara Place Storm Replacement project and has provided the Mayor with an Engineering Report and a final invoice in the amount of \$6,072.00 for services rendered; *and*

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Mayor that said invoice be approved and payment be made to Hogg Engineering Corporation using a portion of the General Obligation Bond in the amount \$6,072.00; *and*

WHEREAS, the City of Selma has established the Sanitary Sewer Improvement account (35.6200.514 430-4) to allocate the payment of such expenses; *and*


WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Selma City Council to assent to the Mayor's recommendation and pay said invoice there from.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama as follows:

The City Treasurer is hereby authorized to remit payment to Hogg Engineering Corporation in the amount of \$6,072.00 for professional services rendered relevant to the O'Hara Place Storm Replacement project; *and*


