WHEREAS, the City is leasing the management of the St. James Hotel to Gourmet Services, LLC; and


WHEREAS, during the transition of the management lease, there is a need for an architectural consultant over the next sixty days; and

WHEREAS, the City of Selma desires to enter into agreement with Richard Hudgens to provide said services; and




