

RESOLUTION
R 249 - 06/07

WHEREAS, the Selma City Council adopted a resolution on June 10th 2002 establishing a policy whereby retiring law enforcement employees of the City of Selma, upon meeting certain eligibility criteria, may obtain possession of their badge and weapon as a part of their retirement benefits; *and*

WHEREAS, said resolution prescribed the following requirements that a retiring employee must satisfy to be qualified for possession of his/her weapon, to wit:

- a. *Employee must have a minimum of ten (10) years of service with the City of Selma Police Department; and*
- b. *Employee must be in good standing with the City of Selma; and*
- c. *Employee must provide a letter of intent to the Mayor and Selma City Council stating the desire of the employee to retire and request for acceptance of the same.*


WHEREAS, former Selma Police Officer Clinton Peoples has communicated his desire to retain his duty badge and weapon; *and*

WHEREAS, Clinton Peoples was employed with the Selma Police Department for 15 years, beginning April 1, 1991 and retired on disability as of June 30, 2006.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELMA, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS :


The Selma City Council hereby grants to Clinton Peoples possession of his service badge and weapon as apart of his retirement benefits.


